

Code of Hospitality

To Visiting Officials

Pre Match

Tea/Coffee to be served upon arrival, up to an hour in advance of kick-off.

This is to be served in either the hospitality room or that part of the Club House designated.

A home Club Official to be specifically responsible for greeting visiting officials and looking after them.

Half Time

Tea/Coffee and biscuits available.

This is to be served in either the hospitality room or that part of the Club House designated.

An invitation to be extended to return to the same location at full time.

Full Time

Sandwiches with tea/coffee, or other drink, as preferred, in either the hospitality room or that part of the Club House designated.

Note: at a Clubs preference, sandwiches may be served at half time, with biscuits then being available at full time)

To Match Officials (and, if appropriate: Assessor)

Pre Match

Tea/Coffee available on arrival.

This is to be served in either the hospitality room or that part of the Club House designated or the officials changing room, as the Officials require.

It is also recommended that an expenses form to be left in the officials changing-room prior to their arrival.

Half Time

Tea/Coffee or squash as required, served in the Officials changing-room and an invitation to partake of post-match food in the hospitality room or that part of the Club House designated at the end of the match.

Full Time

Tea/Coffee, or other drink, as preferred, served in the Officials changing-room.

Post match food to be taken in the hospitality room or that part of the Club House designated.

Visiting players (up to 17 Players, plus Manager plus Trainer)

Pre Match

Tea/Coffee to be served upon arrival, up to an hour in advance of kick-off.

Half Time

Tea/Coffee or squash as required, to be served in the dressing room

Full Time

Sandwiches with tea/coffee or squash, as required, to be served the hospitality room or that part of the Club House designated.
